

Examinations update from Mr McGlue

The recent update from CCEA (30th March) stated that "teachers/learners may wish to continue to cover the content and learning outcomes in the relevant specification, if circumstances allow, to help prepare the learner for the next stage of their education, training or employment".

Whilst there is no final decision yet from the exam boards in terms of how a grade will be awarded, the information given to date has centred around a grade based on prior attainment as well as predicted grades. Therefore, students may want to make sure that they have courses completed if this is a situation which arises for them. We encourage students to keep their options open and work to complete their courses. This is particularly important for Year 11 and Year 13 students as many Year 12 and Year 14 courses built on the knowledge obtained in the first year of the course.

In addition, many will want to continue with study next year, therefore they should continue learning and challenge themselves, so they are as well prepared as possible for further study.
